Each registered dog will receive a rosette and a material prize!

Program: (indicative – after the Russian Toy breed judging)

14:00 Dog acceptance
15.30 Opening
16:00 Judging in the rings

Dogs registered in the Puppy, Junior, Veteran, Honour and Without Competition classes, are not considered the first dog.

For Class inclusion, the dog's age on the day of the show (i.e., on the day of judging at the show) is decisive other conditions must be met on the day of application submission.

CLASSES:

Minor puppy class:	4 - 6 months	Open class:	from 15 months
Puppy class:	6 - 9 months	Winners class:	from 15 months
Junior class:	9 - 18 months	Veteran class:	from 8 years
Intermediate class:	15 - 24 months	Honour class:	from 15 months

Without competition: from 15 months; in this class it is possible to exhibit dogs without the claim for classification and ranking

A complete and legible photocopy of both sides of the pedigree of the registered individual must be attached to the application for the show. If the titles justifying inclusion in the Winners Class are not properly documented, the organizer is obliged to include the dog in the Open Class. Reassigning a dog from class to class at the show is only possible with the written consent of the organizer and is allowed only if there was a breed or gender mix-up, or if the incorrect class inclusion was caused by the organizer.

COMPETITIONS :

Best pair of Dogs: A dog and a bitch of one breed, including the FCI non-recognized breeds, that were judged at the show and are owned by one owner.

Best of Breeding Groups: A breeder may register in the competition a minimum of three and a maximum of five individuals of one breed from his own breeding that come from different intercourses (at least from two different fathers or mothers) and were judged at the show, including the FCI non-recognized breeds. These individuals need not be owned by the breeder.

CERTIFICATES:

CAJC: Can be awarded in the Junior class to individuals with the Excellent 1 rating.

CAC: Can be awarded to individuals in the Intermediate, Open, Winners classes with the Excellent 1 rating.

Res. CAC: Can be awarded to individuals in the Intermediate, Open, Winners classes with the Excellent 2 rating.

AWARDED TITLES:

Best Minor Puppy title can be awarded to an individual from the Very Promising 1 competition.

Best Puppy title can be awarded to an individual from the Very Promising 1 competition.

Best Junior - BOJ title can be awarded to an individual from the Excellent 1 CAJC competition.

Best Veteran - BOV title will be awarded in the Veteran Class to the winner from the Excellent 1 competition (dog, bitch).

BOB title: The competition includes the dog and bitch with the Excellent 1, CAJC Club Junior Winner, the dog and bitch with the Excellent 1 CAC Club Winner, the dog and bitch with the Excellent 1 from the Veteran Class and the dog and bitch with the Excellent 1 from the Honour Class.

BOS title: The competition includes all participants in the BOB competition of the opposite sex to the individual who won the BOB title.

Best Without Competition title: Both individuals with the first place in the Without Competition Class (dog, bitch) compete.

Awarding of titles and certificates is not obligatory!

GENERAL PROVISIONS:

The show is held according to the ČMKU exhibition regulations and is open to dogs and bitches of all breeds registered in books recognized by the FCI, who have reached the age required for class inclusion on the day of the show. The organizer of the show is not responsible for damages caused by the dog or exhibitor, nor for the death or loss of the dog. During the show, owners must secure their dogs to prevent mutual attacks or possible injury to people. Free running of dogs is not allowed. The exhibition committee may refuse to accept an application, but the reasons must not contradict the valid ČMKU regulations and must be communicated to the exhibitor. Dogs not listed in the catalog are excluded from participation (exceptions are dogs not listed in the catalog due to the organizer's fault, and dogs whose evaluation is the basis for inclusion in the Auxiliary Register); sick and suspected sick dogs, dogs after injury, bitches in the second half of pregnancy, nursing and in-heat bitches; dogs owned by persons who have been deprived of the right to exhibit; dangerous dogs – biting and aggressive towards people and dogs; dogs with cropped ears. Color varieties are judged according to ČMKU regulations. Unless otherwise stated in the propositions, the provisions of the ČMKU exhibition regulations, the Animal Protection Act during public performances or dog evaluations of the Czech-Moravian Cynological Union apply. If the show is not held for objective reasons, the entry fee will be used to cover the exhibition costs. The exhibitor is obliged to pay the entry fee even if they do not participate in the show with the dog. Bringing puppies and their sale at the show is prohibited (entry is allowed for puppies properly registered for the show). It is forbidden to groom the dog on the exhibition grounds using any substances or tools. Only cutting, trimming, combing, and brushing are allowed. It is also forbidden to tie the dog to the grooming table for longer than necessary for grooming. Violation of this provision may result in the immediate exclusion of the dog from participation in the show.

Exhibitors are reminded that random identity checks of dogs will be carried out at the show. Exhibitors are advised to check the readability of tattoos or chips in advance. The exhibitor is obliged to present the pedigree for tattoo number or chip verification upon request.

VETERINARY CONDITIONS:

All participating animals must be clinically healthy. Dogs must be equipped with a pet passport or vaccination certificate and must have valid rabies vaccination in accordance with § 4 para. 1, letter f) of

the Veterinary Act. Dogs from EU member states and third countries must be accompanied by a valid pet passport and must meet the conditions set by the European Parliament and Council Regulation 998/2003 of May 26, 2003. During the show, owners must secure their animals to prevent mutual attacks or possible injury to people.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE SHOW:

- Dog's pedigree or confirmation from the studbook that the pedigree will be issued (Puppy, Junior Classes)
- Dog's vaccination certificate or passport with valid rabies vaccination

PROTEST:

Protests against the judge's verdict are not allowed. They can only be filed for formal reasons, in writing during the judging in the ring, along with a deposit of 2000,- CZK with the show director, which is forfeited if the exhibition committee decides against the exhibitor.

Informed Consent for Personal Data Processing:

The exhibitor acknowledges that the show organizer must process their personal data in the usual manner for the proper conduct of the show and agrees to this. The show organizer is obliged to handle this data in accordance with the European Parliament and Council Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of April 27, 2016, on the protection of individuals concerning the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data. Archiving and shredding of this data are carried out in accordance with the ČMKU regulations and directives.
